The Chairman presented to the board the minutes of the 102nd Special Meeting for their comment.

Dir. Quintal proposed to insert the word "if" between "that" and "there" of line 46 in page 6 of the minutes.

On motion of Dir. Quintal duly seconded by Dir. Salanga, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION NO. 1158-2019

"BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the NTA Governing Board approves the Minutes of the One Hundredth and Second (102nd) Special Meeting of the NTA Governing Board, as amended, held on 23 October 2019 at the Conference Room, 34/F Land Bank of the Philippines Plaza, M.H. Del Pilar corner Dr. J. Quintos Streets, Malate, Manila.

UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED......"

B. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

CONSTRUCTION OF NEW NTA BUILDING

Dr. Lopez informed Secretary Dar that the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) has already approved the initial release of fund for the first phase for the construction of new NTA Building, which is included in the National Expenditure Program for FY 2020. However, Dr. Lopez relayed the opposition of Senator Cynthia A. Villar on the proposed project.

Secretary Dar noted that the amount allocated for the said project is not included in the General Appropriations Act for FY 2020. He said that there will be no issue on the matter as long as the DBM approved the budget to be taken from the NTA's Special Account created under Republic Act No. 4155. However, he said that NTA should study the possibility of reducing the number of floors but below total amount P2 Billion.

On motion of Dir. Salanga, duly seconded by Dir. Quintal, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION NO. 1159-2019

"BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the NTA Governing Board hereby authorizes the NTA Management to proceed with the project: "Detailed Engineering Design and Construction of an NTA Office Building with Retail Facilities, located at Panay Avenue corner Scout Reyes Street, Quezon City", through competitive public bidding; Provided, that the total cost for the project should not be more than TWO BILLION PESOS (Php2,000,000,000.00).

UNANIMOULSLY APPROVED....."

Dr. Lopez added that the DPWH has already approved the detailed costing for the demolition of the old NTA Building. She then requested for clearance from the NTA Governing Board for NTA Management to proceed with the demolition project.



On motion of Dir. Quintal, duly seconded by Dir. Casela, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION NO. 1160-2019

"BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the NTA Governing Board hereby authorizes the NTA Management to conduct the public bidding for the project: "Demolition of the Old NTA Office Building located at Panay Avenue corner Scout Reyes Street, Quezon City", with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the total amount of FOUR MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN & 50/100 PESOS (Php4,546,627.50).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the NTA Management should require the contractor to strictly observe safety measures in implementing the said project and to secure all necessary insurance coverage.

UNANIMOULSLY APPROVED....."

2. INITIAL PRESENTATION OF THE DRAFT TOBACCO INDUSTRY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (TIEP)

Ms. Benosa presented the initial draft of the TIEP to the NTA Governing Board. Ms. Benosa informed the board that the initial output was the result of series of consultation with the Branch Offices and concerned Departments. She said that the TIEP is a 5-year program intervention for the tobacco industry and benefit the tobacco farmers to be funded by R.A. No. 4155. She said that the program will encourage partnership with the local government units through tapping their shares from the tobacco excise tax collection pursuant to Republic Act Nos. 7171 and 8240. The program also seeks to modernize tobacco farming to lessen the cost of production, organize farmers' groups, increase the farmers' income through other income generating activities and expansion of the TCGS coverage from 4,000 to 8,000 farmer-cooperators.

Ms. Benosa also presented some statistical data as benchmark, such as, among others, yield per hectare, average income, comparison of performance between NTA assisted farmers and those assisted by the tobacco companies.

Secretary Dar made the following suggestions for NTA to consider in the improvement of the TIEP, to wit:

- Conduct further study to benchmark the local tobacco industry's competitiveness level in comparison with other countries, such as lowering the cost of production through research and to focus on necessary farming interventions to be provided;
- Study on how to double the net income of tobacco farmers within the 5-year period;

- Ensure that all tobacco farmers will become members of cooperatives/associations and adopt clustering of farmers' group with specific farm activity per area, as a condition for providing subsidies; and
- d. Farm mechanization program should cover all aspects from land preparation to marketing of produce.

Secretary Dar noted that the Contract Growing System is one of the long proven good strategies on farm consolidation. However, this farm consolidation should be developed into a new paradigm wherein both private sector and farmer sector are placed in a winwin arrangement. He made as an example of a place at Alang-Alang, Leyte, wherein a French and Filipina couple adopted a cluster farming system in partnership with a number of farmers by providing investments such as putting up farm facilities, imparting knowledge on best agricultural practices and providing credit which has significantly increased the farmers' income by 400%. He also mentioned of the same scheme adopted for corn production in Mindanao spearheaded by investors from Ilocos Sur and Pangasinan. He then encouraged NTA to look into the possibility of encouraging businessmen to invest in the tobacco industry that will also take care for the welfare of the tobacco farmers.

Secretary Dar then set January 18, 2020 as the deadline for the finalization of the TIEP, with Mr. Rex Antonio Teoxon as DA representative, to review the output prior to presentation to the private sector. He then set March 2020 as the date for the submission of the TIEP for final approval by the board.

3. RESULT OF LABORATORY ANALYSIS OF THE FERTILIZERS SUPPLIED BY UNIVERSAL HARVESTER INC. (UHI)

Dr. Bonoan reported the result of analysis of the fertilizers supplied by UHI. He said that the samples taken complied with the requirements of the NTA except for the 10-18-24, wherein the K content resulted to 23.62 or 0.38 less, which he said is an acceptable level.

Dir. Victorio suggested that NTA should consider the brand of fertilizers, particularly the Swire which is not good on soil.

Secretary Dar said that the conclusion of Dr. Bonoan is not indicated in the report. He said that he will not tolerate next time the distribution of fertilizers not in accordance with the specifications. He further instructed Dr. Bonoan to undertake the necessary research study on the effect of the 10-18-23.62 fertilizer on the standing tobacco crops and to consider the suggestion of Dir. Victorio.

C. AMENDMENT OF THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE IFOIGAP-TCGS AND MOBILITY SUPPORT FOR EXTENSION PROGRAM

Ms. Riñen reported that the two (2) guidelines are continuing projects of the NTA, except for specific provisions which are recommended for amendment.

On motion of Dir. Casela, duly seconded by Dir. Salanga, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION NO. 1161-2019

"BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the NTA Governing Board hereby approves the proposed amendments to the following:

- 1. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE INTEGRATED FARMING AND OTHER INCOME GENERATING ACTIVITIES PROJECT TOBACCO CONTRACT GROWING SYSTEM (IFOIGAP-TCGS), WITH ADDITIONAL PROVISION FOR THE COLLECTION OF SERVICE FEES EFFECTIVE CROP YEAR 2019-2020, AS WELL AS, THE GRADUATION OF SERVICE FEES EFFECTIVE CY 2020-2021; AND
- 2. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE NTA MOBILITY SUPPORT FOR EXTENSION PROGRAM, REMOVING THE PROVISION REQUIRING THE ACCUMULATED LEAVE CREDITS AS ONE OF THE QUALIFICATIONS OF AVAILEES.

UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED......"

Secretary Dar informed the Members of the Board that he received a report on the proliferation of tobacco varieties planted in Cagayan Province which has not undergone protocol research and this may pose danger to existing varieties, such as introduction of new plant pests. He inquired on the role of the NTA on this aspect and required the NTA to report on the action to be undertaken.

D. REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF BATEK TOBACCO IN THE TOBACCO GROWERS OF THE YEAR AWARDS FOR 2019

Ms. Riñen requested from the NTA Governing Board for the inclusion of the Batek Type as one of the categories for the Tobacco Grower of the Year Awards – National Level. She reported that the Batek type has recorded a total of 675 tobacco farmers tilling a total of 1,475 hectares. She informed the members of the board that the Batek type is a chewing tobacco type sold in Visayas and Mindanao areas. She further said that the minimum area of 1,400 hectares to qualify for the national level has already been met.

Dir. Quintal noted that there must be a unified package of technology for all areas to be able to have a competition among the producers of Batek tobacco. Secretary Dar said that there is no issue as to different technology as these are location specific.



On motion of Dir. Quintal, duly seconded by Dir. Salanga, the board adopted the following resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION NO. 1162-2019

"BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the NTA Governing Board hereby approves the request of the NTA Management to include the Batek Tobacco Type as one of the categories for the Tobacco Grower of the Year Awards — National Level, starting with CY 2018-2019.


